

Death of Mr Henry Lawrence.

Another old pioneer in the person of Mr. Henry Lawrence died at his residence, Jennapullen, on Tuesday evening last after a short illness. The deceased gentleman, who had reached the advanced age of 81 years, contracted influenza about a fortnight ago and internal complications intervening he died as stated. Mr. Lawrence was a native of England, and came to this State nearly half a century ago. Shortly after his arrival he settled in the Northam district, where he resided up to the time of his death. A family of four sons, Messrs. W. H., Richard, Alfred and Joseph Lawrence, and two daughters, Mesdames K. Rose and Griffiths, survive him. The funeral took place on Wednesday, the place of interment being the Anglican portion of the Northam cemetery. The Rev. R. H. Moore conducted the funeral service. The pallbearers were Messrs. Wm. and Walter Watson, Fred and A. Beard, J. M. Carroll, and R. Dudley. The funeral arrangements were carried out by Messrs. H. & H. Withnell.
