THE LATE MRS. M. A. WATERS

AN OLD COLONIST PASSES

The funeral of the late Mrs. Mary Ann Waters, of Dewar's Pool, who died in Perth on Monday last, took place at Culham on Tuesday.

Mrs. Waters, who was over 93 years of age, came to Australia from England in a sailing vessel at the age of three years. Her late husband, Mr. Thomas Waters, was the Royal Mail carrier between Perth and York in the early days, travelling on foot and horseback and always carrying a gun for protection. For his services he was paid £1 per month.

Mr. and Mrs. Waters eventually settled at "Woodhall", Toodyay, now owned by Mr. Stan Cook.

Three sons and two daughters survive Mrs. Waters, Messrs. R. Waters, J. Waters and W. Waters; Mrs. A. M. Ferguson and Mrs. R. Rodgers, of Toodyay.

The service at the Culham Church was conducted by the Rev. F. Burt, the pallbearers being Mr. J. Britt, Mr. W. Harrington and Messrs. Lee.

Many beautiful floral tributes were placed on the grave.
