He led his pletoon in the first wave of the attack. On striking the first enemy positions west of VAIRE wood strong opposition was encountered. He personally killed one Officer and several other men, and the balance, including one Officer and 20 other ranks, he captured. In this encounter he took one machine gun and one heavy minenwerfer. In his advance he next encountered a mechine gun nest near the South end of the COPSI in front of VAIRE Wood. He again led his men in an impetuous charge. Some 6 of the enemy were killed, two of whom lieutenest MINCHIN himself accounted for. The balance of the crews, also the guns were captured. At this stage he discovered that his Commany Commander had been willed. He thereupon assumed Command of his Company: superintended its operations, and brilliantly completed the teak assigned to the Company. Throughout the whole operation he set a magnificient example of gallantry and leader—ship.  He is very strangly recommended for distinction.
